

## Early Scholar Session

The Canadian Journal of Regional Science / Revue canadienne des sciences régionales is organizing an Early Scholars Session at the 66th annual North American Meeting of the Regional Science Association International (RSAI) in San Antonio TX on November 7-10, 2018.

CJRS/RCSR encourages scholarship in a broad set of social set of disciplines including economics, human geography, political science, sociology. For this session, accepted papers will be in the area of urban and regional (or place-to-place) analysis or spatial analysis, focus on empirical analysis and/or modeling, and be based in the social sciences or kindred disciplines (e.g., environmental science, transportation engineering, public policy, public health, public administration, immigration and settlement, or housing). Broadly, this session will focus on impacts on, and of, human behavior in local environments.

The Early Scholars Session is intended for graduate students, post-doctoral fellows, and other early-career scholars. It is a great opportunity to present before a multi-disciplinary gathering of pre-eminent scholars in the field. Following the tradition in Regional Science, each paper presented is to be followed by discussants selected by CJRS/RCSR.
